The hull was professionally built in 1981 and then placed in a shed from 1981 to 1998. This extended period in the shed allowed the ferro-cement hull to fully cure, which is ideal for ensuring the material's durability and strength before being placed in the water. In 1998, Ian Penney purchased the hull, completed the fit-out of the boat, and launched it in 2001.
